Grandma Remember Me is a beautiful story about a special relationship between a Grandma and her Granddaughter. It explores the importance of memories and relationships within our lives and how to keep and treasure them. Drawing on the experiences of living with someone with dementia, Grandma Remember Me is a moving story told through a mix of puppetry, drama and storytelling. The play is written from the perspective of a young child, Lilly, whose Grandma develops Alzheimer's. It explores their changing relationship and Lilly's eventual understanding of the disease.
